Domestic abuse affects 1 in 4 women and 1 in 6 men in their lifetime. The way you respond to someone who has told you they are experiencing domestic abuse can have a significant impact on their safety and that of their children.

It is important for all staff and volunteers who have contact with members of the public to have an awareness of the issues surrounding domestic abuse and know where to refer people to. Don't miss out on this opportunity to gain these skills.
